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Overview

The worksheets are all completely in English and come along with solutions and additional information.

Every task can be solved individually by the students or as group work. There is a mix of reading, listening and writing tasks.

The worksheets can be used as an introduction to the topic, as additional tasks for fast students or as tests at the end of a topic.

01 – Ireland (8 pages)



- **Facts and figures**
Students learn and research some information about the Republic of Ireland.
- **Places to visit**
By matching name, pictures and information, students learn about 4 famous tourist destinations in Ireland (Cliffs of Moher, Trinity College, Blarney Castle, Glendalough).
- **Hurling and Camogie**
Students discover two real Irish sports and their rules. They test their understanding with a reading comprehension.
- **Limericks**
Students learn about the structure of Limericks and produce their own rhymes.
- **Ireland's Call**
A listening comprehension about the (unofficial) national anthem of the Republic of Ireland.
- **Haunted Castles**
A short reading text about Loftus Hall and its history followed by a creative task (writing an article for a newspaper). There is a link to additional information about the haunted castle which can be watched by the students.
- **Irish Quiz**
Students test their knowledge about all topics above in this multiple-choice quiz.

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02 – Australia (8 pages)



- **This is Australia**
After studying the presentation about Australia, students produce a mindmap with the most important information and their knowledge about the country.
- **Travelling through Australia**
Students plan their trip through Australia by reading hints and information about tourist destinations.
- **Australian wildlife**
By matching pictures, names and descriptions of typical Australian animals, students learn about the fauna of the country.
- **Aussie slang words**
Some typical Australian terms that must be linked with the correct definition.
- **Aboriginal people in Australia**
A reading text with questions about the native people of Australia. This can also be used as a reading comprehension test.

03 – Canada (8 pages)



- **Do you know the country in the North?**
Students solve a gap-filling exercise and learn about interesting facts.
- **Canadian history**
By bringing information in the correct order, students learn about important milestones in Canadian history. They choose matching subtitles for each part.
- **Animals of Canada**
While watching (or just listening) to a video clip about Canadian wildlife, students note interesting and important facts about six animals (squirrel, chipmunk, moose, bear, beaver and racoon).
- **Lacrosse**
A reading text about Canada's national summer sport followed by creative writing tasks.
- **Finding Canadian things**
Word search puzzle about typical Canadian terms. Can be used as repetition or additional task for fast students.
- **Race across Canada**
A game which brings up a lot of information about Canada. There are action and destination cards that ask students to test their knowledge, perform, be creative and think about different topics. All in all, a funny lesson about Canadian cities and tourist destinations.
